Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing to inform parents of the plans for the final weeks of GCSE's. Preparing students for examinations is a team effort and we are very proud of what we have accomplished so far. We are confident pupils will continue to be the best versions of themselves in their remaining assessments, just as they have been in the first 3 weeks of their GCSEs. We wish them well with their continued revision over half-term.

A reminder that all pupils are expected to be in school each day until **Tuesday 11th June**. Latest research shows that 69% of pupils in Year 11 pass at least 5 GCSEs, including English and maths, when schools **DO NOT** offer study leave. This falls to 48% when study leave is offered. This is the reason The Coleshill School is committed to offering our pupils a bespoke revision plan right up until your child's last exam; parental support is greatly appreciated here.

After 11th June, your child will only need to be for their Physics exam, along with Geography and DT examinations if they take these subjects. If your child takes Geography GCSE, it is imperative they attend the full day of revision on **Wednesday 12th June**, as without this they cannot access material on Friday 14th exam.

Our Year 11 Leavers Ceremony will be held on **Friday 21st June** during the morning. This event has been organised for our Year 11 pupils to have time to celebrate the achievement of finishing their secondary school journey. Pupils will be dismissed at the conclusion of this assembly to continue their summer break, where we will see them for one final time at prom on the **12th July.**

Our last request is that your child returns their school **iPad** on **Tuesday 11th June**. This is the day your child will be dismissed for study leave and will have the opportunity to sign shirts. If this device is not returned, pupils will not be able to attend the Leaver's Assembly and we may need to invoice you for the cost of a replacement. Thank you to all families for your continued support throughout your child's time at The Coleshill School. From me personally, as Raising Standards Lead, I am so proud of the journey we have been on together and thoroughly enjoyed supporting Year 11. Returning your iPad

Return of iPads, Cases, Chargers, and Cables

As the academic year comes to an end and students prepare for their final exams, we kindly request your attention regarding the return of school-issued iPad, case, charger, and cable. It is essential that these items are returned promptly and in good condition.

11th June Return Procedure

Students will hand in their:

- · iPad
- iPad case
- · Charger, and cable
- Stylus, lead and charging adapter

Collection will take place in the Wilson Canteen after the Chemistry exam on **Tuesday 11th June 2024**. If they do not have all the items listed above with them on this date, they should return the items to reception after the Physics exam on Friday 14th to ensure attendance to the leavers assembly is permitted.

Device Condition:

To ensure a smooth return process, the iPad must be charged to a minimum of 50% before returning it. All items must be handed in at the same time and be free from any stickers and ink. All items will be passed on for other students to use and therefore need to be in a good condition.

Verification Process:

A member of staff will be present to check each device and record that all the required items have been returned. This verification is crucial to maintain an accurate inventory and to avoid any misunderstandings.

It is important to emphasise that, if students do not return your iPad, case, charger, and cable by the 21st June 2024, they will not be eligible to attend the prom or end-of-year trips or leavers assembly. ATLP may also seek to recover any costs incurred.

Students returning to Sixth Form

For those students continuing their studies with us we will hold their iPad, case, charger and cable for them to use during the induction day and on return in September.

We kindly ask for your cooperation in adhering to the return procedure. By returning these items promptly and in good condition, you will help ensure future students can benefit from the use of these resources.
