## Dear Parents and Carers

As we complete another year at The Coleshill School, we would like to thank you for your ongoing support.

They say it takes a 'village to raise a child' and I thank you for your trust, communication and support to ensure that your child is able to grow, develop and flourish in a safe and healthy environment. All of us (both home and school) have many roles one of which is to reinforce and instill high standards and expectations to support our school and its continued improvement for every child. We continue to make positive changes that benefit our students and their ability to reach their potential, achieving academic success, preparing them for their next steps. This includes changing the timings of lessons within the school day, please see below for more details. We are incredibly proud of our students, and they both inspire and challenge us to continue to work hard for them every day.

We are writing to inform you of the arrangements for the end of this academic year, the return to school in September and key dates for the academic year 2024-2025.

#### Last day arrangements

Our last day at school is Friday 19<sup>th</sup> July, with students finishing and leaving the school site at 3.10pm (normal finishing time).

#### **Return to School**

Schools within The Arthur Terry Learning Partnership (which includes the Coleshill School) will be having two training days (on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> September and Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2024). This will enable us to work collaboratively and plan together for the benefit of our students.

Therefore, the start of term will be staggered for students (please read carefully below). This is for us to ensure that students have dedicated time to discuss the positive learning behaviours we expect of all our students and what this means for them in lessons and around the school. This will continue to support our values of 'Work hard, Be kind, Take responsibility' and our drive to ensure that we have the highest standards and expectations that will be demonstrated by all:

- Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2024: <u>Just Years 7, 12 and 13</u>
- Thursday 5th September 2024: Just Years 7, 9, 11, 12 and 13
- Friday 6<sup>th</sup> September 2024: <u>All students in all year groups</u> at school

Students will arrive on the day as outlined above by 8.35am and in line up by 8.40am (except year 12 & 13). The school day finishes at 3.10pm for all students.

## Changes to timings of lessons within the normal school day


After careful consideration and review of recent educational research, we have decided to adapt the school day, so that there will only be one lesson after lunch.

This change is being made to support our students' learning and well-being. Research has shown that shorter, more focused periods of learning, particularly in the afternoon, can enhance students' attention, retention, and overall academic performance

We will be continuing our offer of free breakfast which we are funding, which is available until 8.20am each day. Our break service will now be five minutes longer, offering students an opportunity for food late morning.

Please be reassured that the number of learning hours will not change, and the start and end of school does not change.
