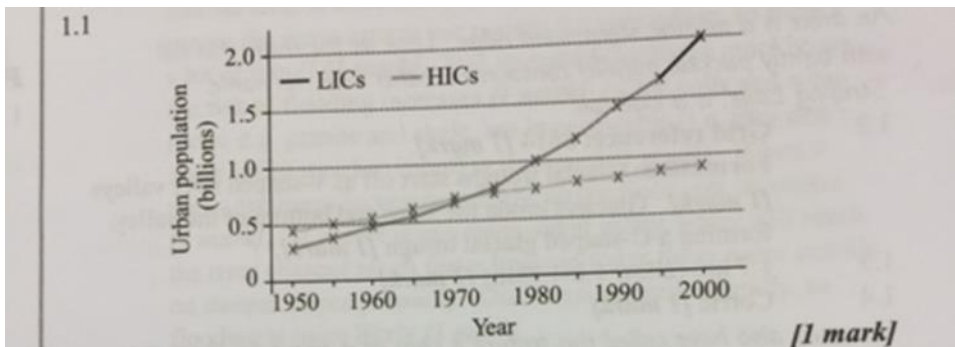


Urban Homework Answers 1

1) Complete the graph to show that the urban population of LICs in 2000 was 2 billion



2) Using Figure 1, describe the trends shown (2)

g 1.2 The urban population of HICs increased gradually from about 0.5 billion to 0.9 billion [1 mark]. The urban population of LICs was less than that of HICs in 1950 but much greater by 2000 [1 mark]. It increased rapidly from about 0.3 billion to 2 billion [1 mark].

3) Complete the following sentences (3)

e 1.3 Urbanisation is the growth in the proportion of people living in **urban** [1 mark] areas. It is caused by natural increase and by the migration of people from **rural** [1 mark] areas. People leave such areas because of push factors, including e.g. **natural disasters** [1 mark] / **fewer jobs** [1 mark] / **difficulty of growing food** [1 mark] / **conflict** [1 mark].

4) Suggest two pull factors that encourage people to move to cities (2)

1.4 Any two from: e.g. there are more jobs in urban areas, and they are often better paid [1 mark]. / To get access to better health care and education [1 mark]. / To join other family members who have already moved [1 mark]. / People think they will have a better quality of life in cities [1 mark].

5) Explain how natural increase contributes to urbanisation (3)

1.5 Natural increase is when the birth rate is higher than the death rate, so the population grows [1 mark]. It's normally young people that move to cities to find work [1 mark]. These people then have children in the cities, which increases the proportion of the population living in urban areas [1 mark]. ...
