Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to inform you of the arrangements for the end of this academic year, the return to school in September and key dates for the academic year 2022-2023.

Last day arrangements

Our last day at school is Thursday 21st July, with students finishing and leaving the school site at 12pm (midday). School buses and taxis have been organised for the earlier pick up time.

Return to School

Schools within The Arthur Terry Learning Partnership (which includes the Coleshill School) will be having two training days (on Monday 5th September and Tuesday 6th September 2022). This will enable us to work collaboratively and plan together for the benefit of our students.
