- 1) Highlight between one and three areas on the maps where there is likely to be high rates of crime. For each area indicated write the following:
 - An explanation of why there is likely to be high crime rates in that particular area.
 - A suggestion of a crime prevention strategy to tackle the crime in this particular area with an explanation of why it would be effective.
- 2) List any signs of poverty in the town with a sentence why each thing you have highlighted would suggest poverty.
- 3) High rates of poverty largely result in an increase of crime suggest which of the following policies you would choose to bring in to lower crime rates in this town with a paragraph explaining why you have selected this and rejected the others:
 - Increase social spending in this area on community projects such as reopening the local youth group, establishing community cafes and running activity days on a regular basis.
 - Increase welfare spending in the area meaning better social housing and each family get more in terms of weekly benefits.
 - Keep welfare and social spending the same and use the money to invest in more policing on the street and cleaning up any physical signs of crime like graffiti.
