Thank you for your continued support with your child, as we have been preparing them to be as ready as possible for their exams. Exams are now beginning and as always, The Coleshill School is determined to support your child in being able to achieve success.

The exam period starts for our students on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> May 2025 and finishes Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> June. You and your child will have received a copy of your child's exam timetable. To support your child, we have constructed a fully timetabled plan of revision lessons. (This can be found in this newsletter and on our school website).

The plan ensures that we provide revision sessions for all students for each subject. These are tailored to the pupils, subject and specification of the exam papers being studied.

Students will be required to:

- Attend all the revision sessions
- Attend school until they have completed all their exams.
- Be dressed in full school uniform
- Ensure that they are equipped for their exams

The last exams that involve the majority of the year group are science on the 16<sup>th</sup> June. Up until that point every hour in school has been designed to provide pupils with dedicated revision and it is vital students access these before each exam.
